In Person

You may attend the Annual Meeting and vote in person by completing a ballot. Attending the Annual Meeting without completing a ballot will not count as a vote. If you choose to vote in person, you must bring proof of identification to the Annual Meeting.

If you return your **BLUE** proxy card by mail, please ensure you leave enough time for your **BLUE** proxy card to be mailed and received. You are encouraged to sign, date and return the **BLUE** proxy card in the postage-paid envelope provided (or vote by Internet or by telephone) regardless of whether you plan to attend the Annual

### Beneficial Owners

If you are the beneficial owner of your shares (that is, you hold your shares in "street name" through an intermediary suc as a bank, broker or other nominee), you will receive instructions from your bank, broker or other nominee as to how to vote your shares or submit a prony to have your shares voted.
